## Voting Information

### Who can Vote?

**You may vote in an Alberta local election as a resident elector if you:**

1. are at least 18 years old;
2. are a Canadian citizen, and
3. have resided in Alberta for the six consecutive months immediately preceding election day and the person's place of residence is located in the area on election day.

### Who is eligible to run as a Council Candidate?

**You qualify as a candidate for municipal council if on nomination day you:**

1. are eligible to vote in that election;
2. have been a resident of the local jurisdiction, and the electoral division (or ward) in which you are running for the 6 consecutive months immediately preceding nomination day, and
3. are not otherwise ineligible or disqualified.

### You are not eligible to be nominated as a candidate if you:

1. are the County's auditor.
2. are an employee of the county unless you are on a leave of absence as granted under the Local Authorities Election Act.
3. are indebted to the county for taxes exceeding \$ 50, excluding current taxes and any outstanding taxes for which the person has entered into an agreement with the county for payment.
4. are indebted to the county for any debt exceeding \$ 500 and in default more than 90 days.
5. have, within the previous ten years, been convicted of an offence under the Local Authorities Election Act.
