BYLAW NO. 1001 OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF STARLAND NO. 47 IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA CANADA

A Bylaw of the Municipal District of Starland No. 47 to establish an assessment review board.

WHEREAS Section 454 of the Municipal Government, being Chapter M-26.1 and amendments included thereto in Bill 32, an Act amending the Municipal Government Act, requires that a Council may by bylaw at any time, but must on receiving a complaint under Section 461 of the Municipal Government Act, establish one or more assessment review boards;

AND WHEREAS, the Municipal District of Starland No. 47 has received a complaint(s) pursuant to Section 461 of the Municipal Government Act, and must now establish an assessment review board;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal District of Starland No. 47 duly enacts as follows:

Section 1 - Short Title

1.1 This Bylaw may be cited as the "Assessment Review Board Bylaw" of the Municipal District of Starland No. 47.

Section 2 - Definitions

- 2.1 "Council" means the Council of the Municipal District of Starland No. 47.
- 2.2 "Municipality" means the corporation of or the area contained within the boundaries of the Municipal District of Starland No. 47 as the context requires.

Section 3 - Establishment of the Assessment Review Board

- 3.1 The Assessment Review Board for the Municipal District of Starland No. 47 (hereinafter referred to as the Board) is hereby established and shall consist of the following:
 - (a) the Board shall be composed of a minimum of three (3) members who shall be appointed by resolution of Council;
 - (b) each member of the Board shall be appointed for a one (1) year term commencing on the date upon which the member is appointed by Council;
 - (c) a simple majority of the members appointed by Council shall constitute a quorum of the Board;
 - (d) no person who is an appointed designated officer of the Municipality may be appointed by Council as a member of the Board:
 - (e) the Board shall elect a presiding officer from its members;
 - (f) any vacancy caused by death, retirement or resignation of a member may be filled by resolution of Council;

- (g) the Board shall not be disbanded, nor a member of the Board be discharged without cause;
- (h) only those members of the Board present at a meeting of the Board shall vote on any matter before it;
- the Board shall hold such meetings as are necessary to fulfil the Board's responsibilities;
- the Reeve of the Municipality may appoint a person as an acting member of the Board if any member is unable for any reason to attend a hearing of the Board;
- (k) the renumeration, travelling and living expenses of the Board shall be paid at the same rates as the renumeration, travelling and living expenses established by Council resolution for the Council members of the Municipality.

Section 4 - Duties of the Assessment Review Board

4.1 The Assessment Review Board shall perform those duties as set forth in Part 11 of the Municipal Government Act.

Section 5 - Severability

5.1 Should any provision of this Bylaw be invalid, then such invalid provision may be severed, and the remaining bylaw shall be maintained.

Section 6 - Effective Date

6.1 This Bylaw shall come into effect and full force upon third and final reading thereof.
