

**BYLAW NO. 1037
OF STARLAND COUNTY
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, CANADA**

A Bylaw of Starland County, to
amend Bylaw 1006, the Craigmyle
Water System Bylaw.

The Council of Starland County, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled
enacts as follows:

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, as amended, provides that a
Council may pass bylaws for the construction, maintenance, and
management of a Public Utility, and

WHEREAS, Starland County has previously passed Bylaw 1006 called the
Craigmyle Water System Bylaw, and

WHEREAS, the Council deems it desirable to differentiate between a
reconnection fee charged to a property that has the service disconnected
because of a discontinuance of payment, and those who have voluntarily
requested a disconnection in accordance with Bylaw 1006.

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF STARLAND COUNTY HEREBY
AMENDS BYLAW 1006 AS FOLLOWS:


1. Section 24 - Water Service Disconnections is amended by adding
Clause (c)
 - (c) A reconnection fee, in accordance with Schedule "A", will be
charged to consumers who have requested a temporary
disconnect in accordance with Section 24(b).
2. Schedule "A" is amended by adding a second reconnection fee for
those who have requested a temporary disconnect:


Reconnection fee (Temporary Disconnect - each occurrence) \$25.00
3. The amending bylaw shall take effect as of the date of the final
reading thereof.
