

## STARLAND COUNTY POLICY MANUAL

**POLICY:** Dust Control

**POLICY NUMBER:** 320-15

**DATE:** March 12, 1996

1. An advertisement requiring applications for dust control will be placed in the Drumheller Mail during the month of May and applications for dust control must be submitted to the Administration Office prior to June 30th of each year. Dust control requests will still be accepted after June 30th, but application cannot be guaranteed unless there are sufficient orders to warrant ordering a truck load of product.

2. The Municipality will offer the following dust control products for approximately 200 metres (656 feet) in front of a ratepayer's residence, for the purpose of dust control at the following costs:

Two Applications (spring and fall) of MG 30	\$3,500.00 (plus G.S.T.)

For existing dust control sites, ratepayers can request rejuvenation of the site with an application of MG 30 at a total cost of \$1,100.00 per site plus G.S.T. The rejuvenation option is only available on oiled dust control sites that have been done within the last three (3) years. Applicants on sites older than stipulated would have to purchase a new application at the price noted.

3. All dust control products are subject to availability, and can be accommodated if a full truck load of the product can be delivered. Dust control products will be applied at rates recommended by the product supplier.

4. The annual road program of Council may include locations where the Councillor for a division includes, as part of his road program, some form of dust control or a road treatment that provides dust control to a ratepayer's residence. Whether or not the resident has requested dust control, if the control provided is a result of the Annual Road Program, the resident will not be charged in accordance with Section 2 of this policy.
