



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

PURPOSE: A public hearing will be held at the above noted time and location with regard to proposed Bylaw No. 1176 to amend Land Use Bylaw No. 1125. The purpose of proposed Bylaw No. 1176 is to add Medical Marihuana Production Facility as a discretionary use in the Rural Small Holdings District (RSH). This would permit RSH landowners to apply to develop a Medical Marihuana Production Facility on their property. Decisions for approval of such developments would remain discretionary upon review by the County's Municipal Planning Commission (MPC).

PRESENTATION: Oral and written comments and suggestions are invited and should be addressed to the point of the proposed amendment. They may be made by any person or group of persons or a person acting on his/her or their behalf, who claims to be affected by the proposed amendment, and by any other persons that the Council wishes to hear at the hearing.

Written submissions may be made by the persons above and may be received in the Municipality office addressed to P.O. Box 249, 217 Railway Avenue North, Morrin, Alberta, T0J 2B0 by 4:00 P.M. on July 19th, 2021. Oral presentation may be made at the hearing by the persons above, whether they have made a written presentation. The time limit of oral presentations is subject to the direction of the Chairperson.

DOCUMENTATION: Copies of the proposed Bylaw 1176 are available for public inspection at the Starland County office during regular office hours.
