PURPOSE: A Public Hearing will be held at the above noted time and location with regard to proposed Bylaw No. 1177 to amend Land Use Bylaw No. 1125. The purpose of proposed Bylaw No. 1177 is to redistrict a portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 18-29-18-W4M from Agricultural General District (AG) to Country Residential District (CR) as shown on the plan below. This would permit the landowner to apply for development permits for those uses listed in the CR district of Land Use Bylaw No. 1125.

Written submissions may be made by the persons above and may be received in the Starland County Office by 4:00 P.M. on September 7th, 2021. Oral presentation may be made at the hearing by the persons above, whether or not they have made a written presentation. The time limit of oral presentations is subject to the direction of the Chairperson.

DOCUMENTATION: Copies of the proposed Bylaw 1177 are available for public inspection at the Starland County office during regular office hours.
