

Employment Opportunity Full Stack Web Developer / IT Technician



Starland County is seeking a highly motivated and intelligent individual to join our team as the Full Stack Web Developer/IT Technician. The County is currently looking to further expand the services offered to our employees and citizens through further developing our own web-based technologies. Our current stack is built on Linux/nginx/Postgresql using the Laravel/Livewire/AlpineJS/TailwindCSS frameworks. We are a small office and so we share responsibilities to cover for each other however, this position will have two primary roles. The majority of time you will be developing and maintaining our web-based systems to manage both private and public data for our employees and citizens. Second is to provide system and network support to our staff. All production servers are fully hosted through 3rd party providers and desktop software is primarily accessed through the cloud.

As the Full Stack Web Developer, you must have a minimum of 2 years PHP software development and HTML/CSS/JavaScript experience. Having experience with Laravel/Livewire framework, intuitive UI/UX design, PostgreSQL, Linux, and NGINX/Apache is preferred. Also serving as the IT Technician, you are required to have a minimum of 2 years IT related experience or certification. Having demonstrated skill in the use and support of Microsoft OS & MS Office is essential. The successful candidate must have effective communication, attention to detail and respect all confidentiality requirements.

- ✓ Write code and use GIT to protect code integrity and to provide record of daily progress
- ✓ Design client-side and server-side architecture under the guidance of our Legislative Services Director
- ✓ Maintain PostgreSQL database, maintain data Integrity and regular backups
- ✓ Maintain existing websites and develop new functionality to better serve staff and citizens
- ✓ Work to understand municipal processes and users' needs to improve quality of services offered
- ✓ Maintain computers, phone, and network hardware for Starland County
- ✓ Maintain, update, troubleshoot & provide support for software applications
- ✓ Offer assistance and support to users with our hardware and software
- ✓ Ensure systems have virus and ransomware protections in place and that data is properly being backed up
- ✓ Coordinate technician assistance if required for repairs to all technical equipment
- ✓ Maintain current knowledge of computer operating procedures and standards
- ✓ Maintain confidentiality policies and procedures

This full-time permanent position will normally work Monday to Friday from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. although there may be occasional work outside those hours.
