• Gravel pricing for the Morton Pit #1 has been determined to be \$13.00/yd³ for ratepayers and \$14.00/yd³ for non-ratepayers.

## • Economic Development Opportunities

Ideas are being passed around and looked into to determine the feasibility and revenue for the County. A greenhouse company has been in contact and they are interested in building a greenhouse for public consumption within Starland County.

#### • 15-Minute Cities
