AAMD&C Scholarship

The Alberta Association of Municipal Districts and Counties (AAMD&C), an organization representing Alberta's incorporated rural municipalities, offers a Scholarship Program in support of rural students attending an Alberta university or college.

Under the AAMD&C Scholarship Program, five rural students each year will be provided with a scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00. To be eligible for this competition, an applicant must be a resident of an Alberta Municipal District or County or the Special Areas, and must be enrolling in their first four years of study. The applicant must not have any previous degrees or diplomas. Preference will be given to candidates attending a recognized post secondary institution in Alberta. Further, the applicant must demonstrate that their course of studies is related in some way to local government and / or rural community interests. The application deadline for the AAMD&C Scholarship Program is July 31, 2009.
